Five Steps to Your Attendance

You need to register separately for the Core Module and the Introductory Module. Both modules can be booked independently.

Step 1: Application

Fill in and sign the => **Application Form** and submit it to => academy@innoval-hc.com. You will receive more information, including a confirmation, and an invoice. Standard rates are €4,860 (program fees) plus €590 mandatory conference package (Core Module), and €970 (program fees) plus €110 mandatory conference package (Introductory Module). Discounts apply as follows:

The **conference package** is mandatory and covers documentation, materials, meals (lunch) and refreshments (coffee breaks), as well as the Summer School reception at Bruneck Castle and special transfers by cable car (funicular) to and from the Kronplatz summit.

Step 2: Confirmation & Reservation

Upon application, you will receive a confirmation of your priority reservation (preliminary registration), information on travel (by car, train, or transfer from airports in Bolzen / Bolzano, Innsbruck, and Munich) and accommodation, i.e., available hotels, plus a code to get access to special room rate discounts at the following recommended Summer School hotels,

Step 3: Payment

Payment options will be communicated as you progress through the registration process.

Summer School places are strictly limited and final allocation will be made on a first come, first served basis according to actual receipt of payment. We regret that preliminary Summer School reservations cannot be guaranteed in advance of full registration and receipt of payment.

For cancellations made before August 01, 2024, conference fees will be refunded less a 10% administrative charge. For cancellations made after July 31, 2024, no refund will be given. We cannot accept responsibility for any additional costs incurred by the participant.

Step 4: Registration

Upon receipt of the downpayment specified above, we will send you a confirmation of your definite registration. Further Summer School pre-reading assignments and additional documentation will be provided electronically. This will include logistics support with regard to travel and accommodation, as well as ancillary information on attractions in the greater Bruneck region, the Pustertal (Val Pusteria), South Tyrol (Alto Adige), and the dolomites.

Step 5: Attendance

At the start of the Summer School, further materials and information will be provided at the venue, the NOBIS conference center in Bruneck.

Substitutions may be made prior to the workshop start date, provided you inform us in writing and complete any registration documentation for the new participant. No substitutions are permissible once the workshop has started.

Deferrals may be granted under extenuating circumstances but will only be valid until the end of the following year – after that there can be no further deferral or refund. In the unlikely event that, due to unforeseen circumstances, the Summer School has to be cancelled, our liability will be limited to a refund of paid conference registration fees only.
